The 2017 Draft Land Preservation Parks and Recreation Plan (LPPRP) is a five year plan that builds on the efforts of the 2012 LPPRP. The plan focuses on enhancing the parks, recreation, and open spaces to meet existing needs, and investing in new infrastructure to meet growing public demand in the County for diverse recreation opportunities. The plan, to be finalized by July 1, 2017, is required to receive Project Open Space funding.
