# **B.** Legislative Updates

Present: R. Christopher Beaver, Metcom General Counsel

Mr. Beaver summarized Bills passed during the last Legislative Session that have an impact on the Metropolitan Commission: House Bill 914/Senate Bill 735 requires the Commissioners of St. Mary's County to review and approve any loan application of the St. Mary's Metropolitan Commission before submission to lender; House Bill 679/Senate Bill 395 amends Section 113-1 of the County Code to allow employment contracts to be offered to certain senior positions; House Bill 1055/Senate Bill 737 alters specific limits on debt of St. Mary's County subjects St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission debt to limitations.

# C. 2018 Proposed Legislation - CHAPTER 113 AMENDMENTS

Commissioner Guy opened the discussion on forming a Task Force to recommend changes to St. Mary's Code, Chapter 113. Recommendations were: The Task Force would meet from June to October and present their recommendations to the full board at the next CSMC/METCOM meeting in November; it would consist of representatives from MetCom Commissioners (2); Commissioners of St. Mary's County (2); Saint Mary's County Delegation Chairman (1); Health Officer (1); MetCom Staff (3) (Executive Officer, CFO, Attorney); County Staff (3) (CFO, County Attorney, LUGM Director) and 2 Citizens; and the County process of appointing members to Boards and Commissions be used to identify citizens on the Task Force. The Task Force will select a chairman from the group.
