Call to Order

Approval of Minutes: None

Old Business

1. Amendment 12-18-1 Island Sink Venting

The Plumbing and Fuel Gas Board must make a request to the St. Mary's County Attorney's office to change the code. The County Attorney will then take the request to the County Commissioners for approval.

New Business

2. Back check valve

The plumbing code requires a check valve when the plumbing is lower than the street. Apparently, it had not been enforced in the past, but now it is being more heavily enforced. There was a discussion about the potential issues with the valve itself not getting cleaned by homeowners, getting clogged, and/or the valve accidentally getting broken by the equipment plumber's use. Also there was a lengthy discussion about the potential liability issues for Metcom for houses on public water and sewer without a check valve. The Town of Leonardtown does not require a check valve.

Mr. Taylor made a motion to set forth a petition to amend the back check portion of the plumbing code. The motion passed with a vote of 4-1.

Other Business

3. Air admittance valve

Tune 8,2016

Mr. Taylor made a motion to accept the amendments of E8.1 through E8.6 of the air admittance valve section of the code book. The motion passed unanimously.
