## Violations:

- Corner Liquors Shambhubhai Keshavial Patel
  - Distribution of controlled dangerous substance paraphernalia in violation of Section 5.04(b) of the Rules and Regulations of the Alcohol Beverage Board of St. Mary's County

The license holders appeared before the Board with their attorney. They admitted that the violation did occur and asked leniency from the Board. Ms. Wood read the facts of the violation into the record. Again, the attorney for the license holders admitted to the violations and apologized to the Board. He also stated that his clients will no longer purchase that type of paraphernalia again. Vice-Chairman Sacks moved to revoke the license, but there was no second. Member Cullins then moved to suspend the liquor license for 30 days and fine the license holders One Thousand Dollars. There was no second. Chairman Saldaña called for a ten minute recess to discuss the meeting rules with Ms. Wood. When the meeting resumed, Member Cullins moved to suspend the liquor license for 90 days and fine the license holders One Thousand Dollars. There was no second. Member Cullins repeated his motion. At that time, Vice Chairman Sacks left the meeting. Chairman Saldaña informed the license holders that no penalty could be agreed on and that they could go.

Since there was no longer a quorum, the rest of the meeting could not be held. Chairman Saldaña advised the audience that the Board Administrator would contact them and advise when the meeting would be resumed.

The meeting was adjourned.
