APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Dement moved, seconded by Commissioner Mattingly, to adopt the minutes of the Commissioners meeting of January 13, 2009, as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

Commissioner Dement moved, seconded by Commissioner Jarboe, to approve and authorize the Commissioner President to sign the Budget Amendment closing out Project US 0928 for Capital Bus Purchases, in the amount of \$340,000, which was not approved by MTA in FY2009. Motion carried 5-0.

Commissioner Mattingly moved, seconded by Commissioner Dement, to approve and authorize the Commissioner President to sign the Lease and Operating Agreement Addendum allowing DMTU, LLC to purchase an existing building from Allied Hangars, Inc., as defined and permitted in the original lease with DMTU, LLC dated January 22, 2002. Motion carried 5-0.

Commissioner Jarboe moved, seconded by Commissioner Dement, to approve and authorize Commissioner President Russell to sign the Special Grant Agreement with the Maryland Aviation Administration in the amount of \$37,360 and the budget amendment in the same amount, to provide for the update of St. Marys County Regional Airports Security Plan, Emergency Plan, and Wildlife Management Plan, and to perform crack-sealing of public use ramp space. Motion carried 5-0.

<u>Re</u>: Request to hold public hearing for the purpose of supplemental grant appropriation (\$997,110) for two MDOT grants to fund design and construction of bus shelter to house STS buses (additional county match of \$110,790 is currently budgeted in FIN09 Cap Reserve).
