Commissioner President Russell called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM.

DELETION TO AGENDA

The decision on proposed St. Mary's County Agricultural Land Preservation District Five-Year Tax Credit Program Ordinance was postponed.

APPROVAL OF CHECK REGISTER

Commissioner Raley moved, seconded by Commissioner Jarboe, to authorize the Commissioner President to sign the Check Register for checks dated July 28, 2009, as submitted by staff. Motion carried 5-0.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Jarboe moved, seconded by Commissioner Dement, to adopt the minutes of the Commissioners' meeting of Tuesday, July 21, 2009, as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

Department of Recreation and Parks, to assist with lighting the Dorsey Park tennis courts, in the amount of \$5,000, and to authorize Commissioner President Russell to execute the related budget amendment to decrease the project budget by \$2,500. Motion carried 5-0.

Beginning at 2:30 PM, the BOCC attended a joint meeting with the Metropolitan Commission, held at the College of Southern Maryland, Bldg. C, Room #216 (Besche Meeting Room), 22950 Hollywood Rd., Leonardtown, MD.

The following topics were presented and discussed:

Metropolitan Commission Task Force (Savich/Meiser)

- Task force members: F. Elliott Burch, Ford Dean, Joe Densford, Shelby P. Guazzo, Glen Ives, Robert T. Jarboe, Susan McNeill, James W. Spence, Mary Lynn Stone, and Frank Taylor; University of Maryland Institute for Governmental Services and Research has agreed to provide staffing (HB 1559 required that staffing be provided by an organizational unit of the University of Maryland.)
- First meeting scheduled for August 26, 2009, at 9:00 AM; BOCC meeting room at the Chesapeake Bldg., meetings will be aired live on Channel 95 and taped for rebroadcasting.
- Three general categories: governance, growth and development review.
- Report due June 2010

Upcoming Loan Agreements (Meiser)

- July 16, 2009, letter to BOCC, advance notice that MetCom will be seeking approval for two new loans toward the end of calendar year 2010; i.e., \$700,000 from the MDE (Maryland Department of the Environment) and \$12 million from the Department of Housing and Community Development.
- Great Mills StreetScape and Patuxent Park Revitalization Effort Phase 2 'Design' (funding in place for Phase 1) moved up a year consistent with county plans

Navy Privatization – Overview and Implications (Meiser)

- Scope initially Patuxent River and Webster field; expanded to include Navy Recreation Center in Calvert County.
- Nothing in enabling legislation that allows (or disallows) MetCom to go outside of the county. What would be the risks to the county if the federal government cannot meet its obligation? Need to have a joint meeting (work session) over the next year to consider pros and cons.

St. Mary's County Comprehensive Plan Update (Berlage)

- 20 year look ahead: 2010 to 2020 23% growth (25k new residents) and 2020 to 2030 16% growth (21k new residents)
- Planning Commission work sessions scheduled during August, 2009; the BOCC will hold its PH / work sessions in the fall, with the adoption goal being December 2009.

- Marlay Taylor ENR Upgrade status
- Co-Generation Project status
- Facility Plan Adoption
