The purpose of the meeting was to take a major action in support of land preservation and prevention of encroachment south of the Patuxent River Naval Air Station in the Mattapany Rural Legacy Area.

Following the introduction of special guests, a staff overview of the Rural Legacy Program and comments from the Commissioners, the following motion was made:

Commissioner Dement moved, seconded by Commissioner Raley, to approve and sign the Resolution which authorizes the Commissioner President to sign the required documents for the purchase of the Fenwick property located in Lexington Park, Maryland, with the following conditions: (1) Up to five lots may be donated to Habitat for Humanity for workforce housing; (2) A site may be developed for the marketing of local agricultural and seafood products on a portion of the property; (3) The County may remove the development rights from the property and sell or transfer them; and (4) The property shall be managed under Forest Management and Soil Conservation plans. The motion carried 5-0.
