President Aud opened the meeting at 3:47 p.m. and at that time turned it over to Governor Hughes.

Governor Hughes stated that St. Mary's County is now certified and has received the "prime" rating. This qualifies the County to participate in the State Department of Economic and Community Development certified counties program. Under this program, St. Mary's County now qualifies for cooperative advertising grants up to \$10,000; the County may participate in special state sponsored trade endeavors in order to lure private investment and loans and grants from the state's industrial and commercial development fund.

The Governor then presented the county with a plaque signifying the county's status. The Director of the Economic Development Commission presented Governor Hughes with a book concerning the Point Lookout Prison by Mr. Ed Beitzel.
