BOARD OF EDUCATION - SALARY ADJUSTMENTS

Commissioner Lancaster moved, seconded by Commissioner Thompson, to allocate \$203,000 for the Board of Education in order to fully fund the seven (7%) percent salary adjustment for administrative and classified employees. Commissioners Loffler, Thompson, and Lancaster voted in favor; and Commissioners Bailey and Jarboe voted in opposition. Motion carried three to two.

ENERGY TAX

Commissioner Loffler indicated that the proposed Recommended Budget for FY 1990 has included a two (2%) percent increase in the Energy Tax, setting it at five (5%) percent.

Commissioner Bailey moved, seconded by Commissioner Jarboe, to go to the budget hearings leaving the Energy Tax at three (3%) as is currently set. Commissioners Bailey and Jarboe voted in favor of the motion; Commissioners Loffler, Lancaster, and Thompson voted in opposition. Motion defeated two to three.


TRI-COUNTY ANIMAL SHELTER
TRI-COUNTY REGIONAL TOURISM

Commissioner Jarboe moved, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, to add \$10,680 for the Tri-County Animal Shelter and \$15,000 to Tri-County Council Regional Tourism. Commissioners Jarboe, Bailey, and Lancaster voted in favor, and Commissioners Loffler and Thompson voted against. Motion carried three to two.
