FISCAL YEAR 1999 BUDGET WORK SESSION

During the budget work session discussion ensued regarding the scheduling of the Comprehensive Land Use Plan.

After discussion Commissioner Jarboe moved, seconded by Commissioner Brugman, to add the Comprehensive Land Use Plan (discussion/decision) for Tuesday, March 24, 1998 at 11:00 a.m. Motion carried three to two with Commissioners Thompson and Chesser voting against. Commissioner Thompson voted against the motion stating she believed (1) the Dissenting Opinion from the Planning Commission should be addressed because she felt there were some misrepresentations in it, and that the issue of the letter to property owners affected by the Agricultural Overlay needs to be addressed.

(Commissioner Eagan responded that if the Plan is approved, the letters can go forward; if it is not approved then it would still give the Commissioners an opportunity to see how people feel about the Agricultural Overlay.)
