Other action items performed by the Electrical Examiners Board:

- The board worked with SMECO to distribute information/policy changes that will affect electrical contractors.
- Rosters of locally licensed electricians were emailed every Thursday evening to MDIA, SMECO, LUGM, other 3rd Party Inspectors and Electrical Board members.
- The Board attended several MUELEC meetings to discuss new proposed legislation concerning electrical licensing and exams.
- The Board held 12 regular meetings.
- The Board deposited \$47,875.00 into the General Fund for fiscal year 2021.
- The Board used \$13,064.57 (91%) of their total \$14,300.00 fiscal year 2021 budget.
