Members reviewed and approved the memorandum from Mr. Baroniak to Walter Burch, citizen, indicating that the Commission will solicit a Financial Disclosure Statement for calendar year 2006 from each of the persons appointed by the Board of County Commissioners to the Rural Preservation District Task Force. The memorandum will be sent to Mr. Burch.

A request was received at the last meeting from the Chief Financial Officer, St. Mary's County Public Schools, concerning non-receipt of a Financial Disclosure Statement from the former Director of Maintenance. Mr. Baroniak reported that he spoke with Robert Hahn, General Counsel, Maryland State Ethics Commission, about proposed ethics training for the southern Maryland counties. Mr. Hahn indicated significant changes are being proposed in the General Assembly to the lobbying section of the State Ethics Ordinance. As soon as decisions have been made and the Ethics Ordinance is

revised, training can be scheduled. All members agreed that the state lobbying changes will be reviewed as soon as approved vis-à-vis the county Ethics Ordinance.
