The meeting was called to order by Mr. Baroniak at 2:08 p.m.

<u>New Member:</u> Mr. Baroniak welcomed Mr. Robert Elwood to the commission. Mr. Elwood has been assigned as an alternate to the commission. Mr. Denning previously filled the alternate position and has now been official assigned as a voting member.

REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES:
