Calendar Year 2003 Annual Report All members of the Ethics Commission have now signed the Annual Report and it

will be distributed and sent to the Webmaster for placement on the Ethics Commission website.

<u>Membership</u>: Dr. Neal reported she had spoken with Mr. Forrest regarding the Ethics Commission's membership needs. Mr. Deaderick reported that there have been two appointments made, one member and one alternate, both of whom have accepted their appointments. Even while Dr. Neal leaves the Commission for family reasons, the Commission will have a full complement of members: five plus an alternate. The new members will be seated once the Commission has approved their Financial Disclosure Statements.

<u>Invoice received from Chen, Walsh, Tecler & McCabe, L.L.P.</u> A final invoice was received in connection with a recent investigation, total amount being \$8,264.31. The motion was made by Mr. Baroniak that this be approved, and seconded by Ms. Gardner. The motion carried.
