In early September, a request for an advisory opinion was received from Mr. Jack Russell, a candidate for election to the Board of County Commissioners, concerning a possible conflict of interest between his employment by a nonprofit organization that, among other things, serves children in the St. Mary's County Public Schools with educational trips aboard its skipjack "Dee of St. Mary's," whose captain is Mr. Russell. Commission members received the request at the September 12 meeting. After opening remarks by Mr. Deaderick, Mr. Russell presented a brief synopsis of his responsibilities in re the Chesapeake Bay Field Lab and environmental tours aboard "The Dee" and outlined the relationship between the Field Lab and the St. Mary's County Public Schools. Assistant County Attorney Heidi Dudderar addressed issues raised by the request. After hearing all testimony and discussing the matter, the Ethics Commission ruled that

there was no conflict of interest so long as Mr. Russell, should he be elected to the Board of County Commissioners, decline participation in matters concerning the particulars of the Board of Education budget pertaining to these trips. Mr. Baroniak will draft an advisory opinion for consideration at the October 3 meeting.
