¹ Low Voltage electrician means a licensed person, determined to be qualified by the Board of Electrical Examiners, who is engaged in the trade or business for the installation, repair, or maintenance of low voltage communications systems listed in the following: Low Voltage systems, telephone, television (including cable), sound systems, public address systems optical fiber cables and intercom systems.

² Restricted electrician means a licensed person, determined to be qualified by the Board of Electrical Examiners, who is engaged in the trade or business for the installation, repair, or maintenance of low voltage and low energy wiring and circuits for fire and burglar alarm systems as defined in the National Electrical Code.

³ Homeowners shall be issued a Homeowners license to perform electrical wiring in their own home under the following board. Homeowner license expires in 2 years.
