- HASMC installed 90 ENERGY STAR® products in The Gateways, including dishwashers and refrigerators, and the use of the ENERGY STAR® name was used for marketing and in the education of residents.
- Other energy saving methods include the use of a high standard steel and dock plank construction resulting in a R19 value in walls, installation of an Aquatherm® all natural gas heating system that supplies hot water and heat, and the use of high performance Pella® Pro-line ENERGY STAR® rated windows that insulate and evenly distribute temperatures. The result is reduced energy consumption, better air quality, increased comfort and noise reduction.
