Reports: Historic Preservation (Grace Mary Brady, Historic Preservation Planner II)

- Worked for 2 weeks+ editing and proofing Ranzetta Book final revisions sent to printers March 12, 2010.
- Documentation of 4 Bridges for SHA (removal from historic inventory) State-wide project.
- Comprehensive Plan handed out approved sections pertaining to Historic Preservation Commission to board members.

- Handled 22 customer service requests.
- March 26th meeting of the St. Mary's County War of 1812 Committee received response from previous letter sent to John Maounis asking that St. Mary's County be included in the National Star Spangled Banner Trail, Raiders & Invaders Map, documentation of primary source evidence, notified elected officials.
- Attended pre-application meeting 2 historic sites.
- Historic Preservation Commission staffed meeting and worked on Preservation Awards choices.

- 3) HPC Newsletter Ms. Erichsen presented the Committee with a 'draft' newsletter reflecting the various categories that would enhance future publications (e.g. calendar of events; quick reference links; news articles). Ms. Erichsen agreed to contact the members of the HPC newsletter subcommittee to schedule a meeting.

Items from the floor – Carol Moody talked about the Southern Maryland Studies Center hosting a "Share Your Stuff" Day: 20th Century War and Peace in Southern Maryland on Saturday, June 12, 2010 from 10 to 2 p.m. at the La Plata Campus. Mr. Willard talked about the Sand Lot Book and how it described a wedding being held at home plate. Staff reminded board members about the upcoming Barn Summit being held on Friday, April 30, 2010. Mr. Tippett asked staff questions about the SHA bridges that had been documented and talked about other bridges in St. Mary's County.
