Ms. Guazzo made a motion to change the priority level of the buildings behind the Museum from A-1 to B-1 and Mr. Willard seconded. The motion failed by a 2-5 vote with Mr. Evans, Mr. Thompson, Ms. McNeill, Mr. Siebert and Ms. Robrecht opposed.

Mr. Evans made a motion pursuant to the Section 27-3.c.1 of the St. Mary's County Code, the Planning Commission has reviewed an itemized list of capital projects that the County proposed to undertake in the upcoming fiscal year and the succeeding five years after, I move that the Planning Commission recommend the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) for approval and that the Chairman be authorized to sign a letter to this affect to be forwarded to the County Commissioners and Mr. Siebert seconded. The motion passed by a 5-1-1 vote with Ms. Guazzo opposed and Ms. McNeill abstaining.

Ms. McNeill indicated for the record that she abstained because she does have issues with the museum project and feels these issues need to be addressed.
