§217-1 of the Code of St. Mary's County, Maryland reads as follows:

The National Electrical Code, (2005 Edition), including all annexes, as adopted by the National Fire Protection Association, (hereinafter, the effective base code shall be referred to as the "NEC"), is hereby adopted as the St. Mary's County Electrical Code, and it is incorporated by reference hereto and is made a part of this Chapter with the same force and effect as though set out in full herein, save and except such changes, amendments, revisions, deletions, substitutions and additions as are specified. Notwithstanding the foregoing, all electrical installations in St. Mary's County shall meet: (a) the standards and requirements set forth by the most recent edition of the NEC beginning sixty (60) days after the first publication of that edition; (b) this Chapter, regardless of changes to section numbers within the future editions of the NEC; and (c) all rules and regulations of the St. Mary's County Board of Electrical Examiners, as amended from time to time.

In a Memorandum dated May 5, 2015, the Board of Electrical Examiners stated that its policy is to conduct a ten week course on content of new and revised editions of the NEC, and that the current ordinance does not allow sufficient time between publication and adoption of the NEC. The Board of Electrical Examiners requested that the Ordinance be amended to extend the time of the effective date of revisions.

SECTION I. §217-1.A.(1) of the Code of St. Mary's County, Maryland, is amended to read as follows:
(1) The National Electrical Code, as revised and amended from time to time, is hereby adopted as the St. Mary's County Electrical Code.
