

Similarly due to hazardous weather conditions, we had to cancel at least one Dinner & a Cruise event.

And yet, we were able to keep going and make it through another year. On a positive note, we did bring on three new senior staff members as well as some new Museum Assistants, all of whom have added a great deal of energy to our operations. We also expanded our great relationship with the Unified Committee for Afro-American Contributions (UCAC) and partnered with them on a series of events at the U.S. Colored Troops Interpretive Center, located in a restored historic flattops structure in Lexington Park.


