B. VOYA Plan Review

Sarala Katta presented the following updates:

Through September 30, 2022, plan assets were \$19,373.753.

\$1,134,457 in contributions were added to the plan in payroll deposits, with an additional \$2,260,860 added in other activity to include revenue credits, fees, and asset transfers.

There were \$984,567 in distributions given which encompassed approximately twenty participants who had a triggering event and left the plan.

The plan balance on 9/30/22 was \$17,626,518.

As of the close of business on 11/16/22 plan assets were \$18.9 million

By the end of September 2022, the plan had surpassed the number of new accounts in all of calendar year 2021.

As of 9/30/22 the plan had 369 participants.

The average account balance continues to be more than the benchmark.

There has been a steady increase in employee engagement with the call center, website, and mobile app.
