3. NEW BUSINESS.

A. VOYA Plan Review, Catherine Pratson

Plan review covers January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022.

- Beginning plan year assets of \$16,395942.47 (later corrected to reflect \$19,373,753.95)
- Contributions of \$1,508,040.65
- Distributions of \$1,359,403.07
- Other Activity of \$2,904,717.07
- Appreciation/Depreciation of -\$3,681,537.05
- End of Period Plan Assets \$18,770,725.00

Plan demographics:

- 36 new accounts
- 11 left the plan
- 375 end of period participants
- 112 terminated employees with an account balance
- 22 terminated employees with an account balance of less than \$5,000
- Average account balance vs Benchmark \$50,055/\$41,829
- Average deferral percentage 9.2%

Summary of Plan assets and contributions show that most plan members are using the target date funds.

Engagement summary shows 56% of plan participants have engaged via the web, 25% have engaged via the mobile app., and 9% have engaged through the call center. On average participants are on track to replace approximately 42% of their income in retirement and 20% of participants are on track to generate at least 70% of income in retirement.

Local engagement shows 327 participants either called, had an in-person appointment, or a virtual appointment during the period. There were 3 group meetings held and 21 on-site days conducted.

B. Authorization for Investment Review (Bolton)

Approval was given by the Commissioner's to use funds from the employee portion of the health insurance premium rebate account to obtain investment advisory services for the 457B plan. Within procurement regulations, this purchase is considered an exempt purchase and competition is not required, though multiple quotes should be obtained.

A. Fee Benchmark Proposal and Investment Review (Mike Beczkowski)

Mike Beczkowski conducted a fee benchmarking study and a 4th quarter analysis of the Plan investments and presented that information to the Committee.

One bill paid for RCM&D for renewal of fiduciary liability insurance in the amount of \$6,726 bringing the escrow account balance to \$4,347.85.
