DPWT Report (Swint, Airport Manager):

- Runway construction update. Still having difficulties associated with old trash area and contractual issues. May be able to put in base, but not pave by end of the year. \$2.5M funding shortfall.

- Pilot's lounge furniture received is discontinued, to be returned

- Deer problem is growing. DNR permit in work for hunting.
