<u>Airport Advisory Board Minutes – 03/27/2023</u>

Meeting Start: 6:00 PM

Chairman's Remarks

AOPA Day held on Saturday (3/25). Good briefs.

Start planning now for forum with NAS Pax River for information exchange.

AeroPark Business Alliance meeting on airport signage 4/13/23, 0830.

DPWT Report: (Swint, Airport Manager, Gary Whipple):

County accepted (from the contractor) new entrance into the airport that will provide access for construction efforts and then will be transitioned to use by all with electronic keyfobs. New entry will come directly to the West ramp. Comments made regarding the high level of cleanliness being exercised by this contractor.

Work on repairs to the fence along Airport Road now complete.

Environmental assessment underway for further work on runway extension. Expect review by FAA and then provide information for public comment before execution. Some changes to methods for disposal reclamation have been found that should prove both faster and less expensive. Anticipate approximately 60 days until fully prepared for execution of the extension. Still expect the extension to be fully completed by end of the year.

The required environmental study /and removal has been reduced in scale and therefore will shorten the time. Next 60 days for completion then the pavement study and pavement rework. The pavement management study will be four core samples – with the results being the recommended rehabilitation.

Some additional tree removal being planned to ensure that approaches to runway 29 are in full compliance with regulations. Airport data and information portal-(ADIP) being used to verify compliance.



Discussion of obtaining the LUGM data regarding new construction near and/or affecting the airport. Board has requested that information regarding construction analysis be shared with AAB.

Inspection with MAA will be conducted on 4/6.

Maryland Aviation Day at Annapolis on 3/22 was hugely successful. Anticipate that it will become an annual event.

FBO Report, (Ken Reed, S. Hunt Aero)

Finishing up Building Z, expected to be completed by end of the week. Beginning signage transition for holdings of S. Hunt Aero.

Pax Air Ops Report: LCDR Hughes

Reviewing updates provided by FAA regarding RNAV runway 11 changes.

Several recent close calls between base aircraft and local VFR aircraft when the duty runway at Pax River is runway 14. Recommend emphasis on aircraft arriving from the east transit enroute to 2W6 at 1,000 Feet.

Final documentation on LOA for R-4007 will be completed by the next meeting and will be voted on at that meeting.

AeroPark update (Katherine Stormont):

Next AeroPark Business Alliance will be held on 4/13 in building 44193 at 0830. Consultants doing signage and way finding plans are being asked to brief full plan at this meeting.

Maryland Economic Development (MEDCO), a private company, reported to be working to provide recommendations on development of the West ramp area and future expansion. MOU with County expected 4/4.

Chairman briefed interactions between UMD Eastern Shore and UMD to further develop flight and maintenance training as it may apply to development of the West ramp area. University of Maryland Eastern Shore has four-year aviation (flying) program, is developing a maintenance program, and is considering expanding both to 2W6. Easy for the flying portion but more difficult for the maintenance expansion.



Old Business: Approval of 2/27/23 Meeting Minutes & Action Items. Motion to approve as written (Hill); second (Lightstone). Approved.

Discussion of approval process for the LOA with Pax River. Recent close calls have heightened awareness of the potential for conflict and need for additional training. Consider providing similar documents and training to GA pilots as is currently provided to new pilots reporting to NAS Pax River. More information in new action item no 38.

Discussion of Security actions taken by Airport Manager and ongoing efforts to improve security. Status regarding actions being taken by law enforcement to determine offender(s) associated with aircraft break ins earlier this year.

Review/Update Action Item list completed. New item added.

Allison Swint suggested that further coordination be established that would have direct interface between Aviation Safety representatives from NAS Pax River and GA pilot population operating out of 2W6. Voicemail was played depicting safety concerns from the safety office from Naval Test Wing Atlantic. First step (action item no 38) is to invite Doug Dickinson (NTWL Safety Officer) to the April meeting of the AAB and attempt to determine the best course of action going forward.

New business:

Discussion of any promotional events such as upcoming AUVSI competition that might need AAB involvement at this time. Distribution of calendaring of special events would allow time for preparation by staff of the Bird Dog Bistro as well as notification to local GA pilots.

Public Comment (Tim Wilson):

Desire for an easy way for the GA community to be aware of the 1000 ft recommendation for aircraft crossing the extended centerline of PAX runway 14 during VFR approach to 2W6. Discussion followed; this relates to action items 13 and 34, and new action item 38.
