The Board instructed the Clerk to Write Mr. Abel Wolman State Engineer of P.W.A., recomending as additional projects from St. Mary's County, the construction of side walk from the end of the Town Limits of Leonardtown to Leonard Hall School entrance, a distance of about 500 ft. and the construction of a walk from the jail in Leonardtown, to intercept the present walk to the Court House, a distance of IOO ft., and alsoma n apron across the front of the jail. The walks to be of Concrete, and to conform with the present walks.
