Mr. Bernard Burch and Mr. A.E. Meredith requested the Board to appropriate towards the construction of a pipe line to provide water for fire protection at Mechanicsville. After conferring with the Attorney to the Board of County Commissioners, the Board decided tity had no authority to contribute or appropriate funds for this purpose.

Miss Bartell and Miss Willie Greenwell, representing the Health Department, requested the Board to pay \$40.00 for exray pictures to be taken of 8 children, now excluded from county schools, suspected of having tubercelosis. The Board ruled it had no authority to authorize this expenditure.

Mrs Addie C. Maddox, Register of Will, requested the Board to defray the cost of painting the Register of Will's Office. The Board requested an estimate of cost, and promised futher consideration.

Mr. Joe Chaney, and Mr. Marshall Dent of the State Roads Commission visited the Board, and discussed the road programe for the present year.
