Board met July 9th.1935. Present F. Harvey Bailey Clarence D. Bradburn Wm. P. Wise.

Minutes of last meeting read and adopted. Mrs. Graydon, requested Board for an appropiation to install Electric Light and Pumping equipment, and improvement of sanitary conditions at Cardinal Gibbons Institute. Also requested the Board to recommend the improvement of road leading to St. Feter Clavers School and Church.

Mr. John H. T. Briscoe, representing Mr. Thos. H. Ridgwell, requested the Board to approve the Tanners Creek Project, for sanitation and costal erosion. Same to be done entirely by ederal funds. Board approved the project.

Mr. T.Lee Mckay, Mr. Thos. Mckay, and Mr. Goddard, appeared before the Board as requested, and stated their objections to the County Commissioners condemning Road Right of Waythrough the property of Mr. TeeLee Mckay. The objection raised was devaluation of property, and proposed road being objectionably close to the residence of Mr. T. Lee McKay. The Board voted not to comdemn the land for road, on the grounds public necessity does not demand building the road.

Father Rudtke requested the Board to look into the matter of drainage of a section of land and roads in the 7th. District, the object being to eliminate the pollution of wells, which father Rudtke claims caused much sickness in that section last winter. His idea being to get Federal aid through the FERA for this work. Mr. Britton was requested to get futher information on this project.

Mr. Alton S. Jump of the Firm of Woolen & Jump, C.P.A. visited the Board and secured the work of auditing the Books of the County Commissiones Office. This work had previously been awarded to Elmer L. Hatter C P A, recently deceased.

The Clerk was instructed to advise the agistrates of the County to return all unsold Dog Tags, and account for those sold by June 17th.1935.
