Any person violating or refusing to comply with the provisions of this law, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be subject to a fine or imprisonment# or both.

Dog tags are now available at the office of the County Treasurer.

June 1st. a Special Officer will be appointed in each District to collect# said licenses, and enforce the provisions of the law.

The Board reviewed the information furnished by the Local Welfare Board, pertaining to those on General Public Assistance. The Board decided to discontinue giving aid in 12 cases, and reduced the amounts previously given by the Welfare Board in 15 other cases.
