Each officer was given a list of the untagged dogs in his district, and directed to make a last call on the owners of these dogs, and to give him a final opportunity to purchase tag for the usual price. In the event of any one refusing to purchase tag, the special officer after having been sworn in as a constable, is to get a warrant from a magistrate serve the warrant on the delinquent. From this point on the case takes the same status as any other criminal case tried before a magistrate.

The Board agreed to allow the Special Officers .50 cents for each investigation made, and in cases where a warrant is served, the specia officer is to get .usual constables fee of .75 to be paid by the delinquent as a part of the costs imposed by the magistrate.
