

Board met Sept 22nd. 1936

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Jas. N. E. Combs, Callaway, Md. requested Board to allow him assistance from G.P.A. Funds. Board voted to allow Mr. Combs \$4.00 monthly.

Mr. Henry Juneman and Major Kirby of Tall Timbers, requested Board to recommend improvement of Tall Timbers Road.

Mr. John Baronak, St. Mary's City, Md, protested to the Board against the County paying any part of Parochial School Transportation.

Mrs. Willie Howard of the Health Department, requested the Board to commit Earl W. Wood, & - Gass to Rosewood Training School.

After due deliberation the Board signed the necessary papers committing these boys to the said Institution.

Dr. Geo. H. Preston, Board Mental Hygiene, requested the Board to commit Jos. Abell, now in a Washington Hospital, to a State Institution for the Insane. Jos. Abell being a resident of St. Mary's Co. the Board authorized Dr. Preston to transfer him to a State Institution.

Miss Dent, Superintendent of Schools, requested Board to allow funds for transportation of children, not now being served by a school bus.

Miss Dent stated that at present there are several children in three different sections of the county, who are not accessible to the school bus, due to their living on roads not used by the bus. Miss Dent's idea is to have some private car collect these children and transport them to the nearest bus route.

The Clerk was directed to write Paul B. Long, Francis Torney, & Corbett Bennett, to kill dogs belonging to them, due to information having been received by the Board that dogs belonging to these parties have killed turkeys, and for which claims have been paid by the Co. Comm.

The Clerk was directed to write all Justices of the Peace, instructing them to supply the name of the owner of dogs, killing poultry etc, this information to be obtained from the party asking damages be paid by the County Commissioners.
