Board met Ocr. 13th. 1936

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

The Board of Election Supervisors waited on the Board of County Comm. informing them it would be necessary to have additional quarters to carry on the work of the Election Supervisors. The County Commissioners authorized the Election Supervisors to take use the Petitt Jury Room.

Mr. R. H. . Pembrooke, Chairman and others of the Welfare Board advised the County Commissioners that W.P.A. & C.C.C. certifications have to be made by the Welfare Board, according to requirements of the Social Security Act. Mr. Pembrooke explained that the present W.P.A. certifications totaled 60. As a result of W.P.A. and C.C.C. activities in the County about \$33,600, 1s being spent here, this year. Mr. Pembrooke explained to carry on this W.P.A. & C.C.C. certification and investigations, by the Welfare Board it would be necessary for the County Commissioners to pay the cost of this work or \$162.50 per Year. Mr Pembrooke stated that the W. B. would administer the G.P.A. fund including the W.P.A.& C.C.C. certifications for a monthly administrative cost of \$85.54 . By so doing the reciptents of G.P.A. funds would be entitled to receive Sur-plus comodities and clothing. Mr. Pembrooke futher stated due to the County Commissioners administering the G.P.A. funds, relief clients do not get the full advantages of the Social Security Law.

After due deliberation the County Commissioners unamiously voted to accept the W.B. proposal to make investigations and certifications for W.P.A. & C.C.C., and authorized the payment of the \$162.50 per year to defray the cost of this work.

Miss Harriett Reeder and Miss Maude Jarboe, requested the Board to render assistance to the family of Raymond Goldsboro, Mechanicsville, Md.

The Board authorized Jno. A. Fowler & Mechanicsville, Md to furnish groceries to the above family to the amount of 12.00 per month.

The Board futher considered the applications of Queenie Smith, "arie Lawrence, Julia Bryant, Elizabeth Barnes, and Jos Bennett for G.P.A.

The Board made allowances as follows, Queenie Smith 6.00, "arie awrence 6.00, Julia Bryant 8,00, Elizabeth ^Barnes 8.00. These amounts to be paid monthly. In the case of ^Bennett, no action was taken, as he lives with his son, who works on the State Roads.
