

Board Met February 23rd. 1937

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Wm. Bush, St. Inigoes, Jos. Barber, Great Mills, Veronica Thompson Callaway, applied for G.P.A.

The Board granted Wm. Bush, and Jos. Barber, \$4.00 a month each.

Mr. Geo. Magrogan, reported to the Board ~~the condition of~~ Geo. Nichols, Compton, Md. has Consumption, and he was in dire need of clothing before he can be admitted to a Sanitorium. The Board authorized Mr. Wm. P. Wise to provide clothing in the amount of \$10.00, and to be paid out of G.P.A. funds.

Captain Ed. Thomas of St. Geo. Island requested the improvement of St. Geo. Island Post Office Road. The Board recommended the improvement of this road to the State Roads Commission.

The Clerk was directed to write Mr. K. O. Webb, that the Beauvue-Valley Lee Road is to be the first road recommended for improvement this year,

The Board authorized the Welfare Board to purchase, supplies such as thread, buttons, needles, tape, etc. used in the W.P.A. Sewing Room, the cost not to exceed \$10.00 per month, and to be paid out of G.P.A. funds. It was necessary to do this because W.P.A. refused to purchase these supplies with Federal Funds.

Clerk was directed to write Ignatius Butler, Chaptico to kill dog.

Clerk was directed to write Senator Coad, Delegates Hayden & Dorsey, at Annapolis, recommending the Licesning of Slot Machines for St. Mary's Co.

Clerk was directed to write Senator Coad, DElegated Hayden & Dorsey, recommending that the law relating to Constables in St. Mary's Co, be so ammended as to allow Constables the same fee as now paid to Deputy Sheriffs. ( See letters on file in all of the above matters).

The Clerk was directed to write the State Roads Commission , recommending the order of preference for the improving of County Roads this years as listed below.
