Judge Carpenter, and Mr. Briscoe Bunting, requeste the Board to recommend the improve ent of Bethel Church- Gardiners's Mill Road, a distance of 21 miles.

Mrs. Ernest Morgan, Laurel Grove, requested G.P.A, claiming her husband could not get work, and could not feed nine children, Board allowed her \$6.00 month, and authorized Harry Murphy, Laurel Grove, Md. to supply provisions in the amount of \$6.00 month, until futher notice.

Mrs. Godcharles, & Grover Stone, requested G.P.A. for Sam Tabbott, Chaptico, Md. Board allowed \$4,000 mo, to be sent to Etta Cooper, Chaptico.

Melinda Barnes, Ridge, Md. applied for G.P.A. Board regused to grant aid.

Mrs. Roland Higges, Oraville, requested aid for her 14 year brother, aniel Tippett. Board refused aid in this case.

Mr. Harvey Bailey called the Boards attention to the case of Jim Mason, Abell, Md, recently disabeled, and in need of help. Mr. W. H. Mattingly was authorized to provide food in the amount of \$3.00 per week until futher notice.
