Minutes last meeting read and adopted.  
A delegation from the Mechanicsville Fire Department waited on the Board, requesting an appropriation for that Department.  
The Board voted to allow \$400.00 to the Mechanicsville Department and \$800.00 to the Leonardtown Department.

Right of Way Deeds for section of Road to Buzzards Point, from Harold Knight, and from Frank Russell White, Continuation of St. Jerome's Neck Road, were accepted by the Board, and recommended to the S.R.C. that these two sections be accepted as a part of St. Mary's County Road System for maintenance.

Miss Dent of the Board of Education again interviewed the Board, and further discussed the needs of the School Board for the coming year. Primarily she requested that the School Board be reimbursed in whole or part for funds advanced for completion of Great Mills Elementary School, that funds be provided for addition to the Chaptico White School, \$700.00 and that a \$1,000.00 be provided for the construction of a new Colored School near Chaptico.

Mrs Rykard of Patuxent Beach complained of parking condition in the public road leading to her property, and requested No Parking Signs be posted. Mr. Webb of the S.R.C. was advised of the situation.

Mr. O'Dea requested improvement of road to Harry James Neck, near Scotland.

Geo. Woodland, Oakley, Geo. Bryan, Hermanville, and Jas. E. Greenwell, Great Mills, were given \$4.00 each per month from G. P. A. Funds.

Miss Hannah of the Health Department, requested the Board to provide funds to pay Doctors of the County in maternity cases, where the mother was unable to pay for this service, thereby eliminating the possibility of death due to child birth. The action of the Board was unfavorable in this matter.

The Town Commissioners of Leonardtown requested Board to Appoint Messrs Howard Britton and Barnard Smith, Constables. Board acted favorably.

Clerk was directed to write State Roads Commission in reference to transfer of Construction funds to the account of maintenance.  
In reference to the Valley Lee - Beauvue Road.  
In reference to Road employees working 10 hr, 6 day week.  
In reference to Debt Service for next fiscal year.

Clerk was directed to write Dr T. B. Symons, with respect to increasing Extension Service Appropriation. See letter on file.

Board appropriated \$4,500.00 for O. A. R. for the next fiscal year, and also provided for the cost of the ~~#####~~ re-assessment, both items to be included in the 1937 Levy.
