

Board met June 22nd. 1937

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Mr. Norman Yates interviewed Board in futher reference to improvement of road connecting Compton State Road with # 17 Road. Board agreed to recommend improvement of Road to State Roads Commission upon receiving Deed for Right of Way.

Mr. Dudley Owens Great Mills Md, requested Board to get action##### on his road, recommended to the State Roads Commission over a year ago. Board agreed to see that work was done this year.

Mr Martin Gasparovic requested Board to take some action towards improving the St Andrew's - St. Nohn's Road. Board promised Consideration.

Mrs Wm. E. Curley requested improvement of Road from #5 to Calvert Restt. Board promised to interview Mr. Webb, and see if gravel could be put on worst sections.

Mr. Oswald of Extension Service interviewed Board, and discussed and explained the Estension Service Set Up in this County. Hee explained the need of additional funds for the improvement of the Service and to place St. Mary's County, comparatibe basis with the other Counties.

Clerk directed to Write Dr. Symons that \$300. increase appropriation would be made for Extension Service, provided that Miss Long's Salary be increased to \$750.00 per year, it being the opinion of the Board that Miss Long's present salary is inadequate for services performed. See Letter on file.

Mrs. Matthews of the Welfare Board reported information from the W.P.A that all W.P.A. Projects in St. Mary's County would be discontinued June 29th. The Board did not see fit to protest the discontinuance of WPA programe.

The Board authorized the levying of \$500.00 for addition to Chaptico White School, (1937 Levy), but refused the other requests of Miss Dentie, reimbursement for funds spent by School Board for completion of Great Mills Elementary School, and the building of a new Colored School at Chaptico.

Board authorized the levying of \$900. compensation to Treasurer for collecting State Taxes. (1912 Chap.225, Sect 25). 1937 Levy.

Board authorized the payment of \$1,100.00 plus \$165.00 interest to County Trust Co, payment on Great Mills Elementary School Note Sept.1st. form G.P.A. Funds.

Board decided to appoint special officers for selling of dog licenses, and enforcement of dog law. These appointees to report at the office of the County Commissioners June 30, for tags and instructions.
