Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Mr. M. M. Coleman, laid before the Board Plat of survey made of his farm to support his plea for refund of taxes paid in error. This survey shows 348½ acres. Board advised Mr. Coleman to have the correct acreage noted in the Land Records, in Clerk's Office.

Mr. Mattingly Johnson requested Board to take over as County Road section of Woodlanding Road in 7th Dist. Mr. Webb requested to make a report on this road.

Mr. Frank Bailey and others requested improvement of Robert Long Road, 3rd. & 6th. Dist.

Mr. K. O. Webb advised the Board that a shovel was badly needed for work on county Roads, and that his forces could not accomplish permanent results without one. Clerk directed to write S. R. C. in the matter.

Mr. Webb was requested to grade a section of road at the end of Morganza-Kopel's Pt. S. R. leading to Colton Pt. Wharf.

Mr. Geo. Washington Williams advised Board by letter that he had been retained by Mr. Dudley Coppage to regain a tract of land, sold by the County Commissioners, known as No. Man's Land in the 2nd. Dist, for taxes. This tract of land was purchased by Dr. Griggs, of Washington. The matter was referred to Mr. King & Mr. Adams.

Mr. Jos. H. Blandford, Co. Comm. Pr. Geo. Co. advised the Board there would be a hearing before the S. R. C. in Baltimore Oct. 6th. in an effort to get the said Commission to improve the Crain Highway. The Board was requested to attend the hearing, supported by a delegation interested in the proposed improvement. The Board decided to attend.
