At the request of the State Road Commission, the County Commissioners met in special session to meet and discuss road matters with the State Road Officials, for the coming year.

Commissioner Ludhart, & Wilkerson, Chief Engineer Smith, Chief Auditor Codd, District Engineer Chaney, & Mr. Webb, were present.

Mr. Smith advised the County Commissioners that St. Mary's County would receive from the lateral gasoline tax approx.	51,599.
