Minutes last meeting read and adopted. Mr. Elmer Jarboe heading a delegation petitioned the Board to improve the Hilly Lee Road from Mechanicsville to Chaptico, about 2 1/2 miles. Board promised consideration.

Hewitt requested G.P.A for Will Matthews, Valley Lee, Jeremiah Green, St. Inigoes, Matilda Butcher, Beachville, Mary Millard, St. Inigoes, Calib Millard, St. Inigoes, Mary Francis Tyer, Loveville Carry Schoolfield, Jno. W Davis, Wm Hall, Scotland, Rodie Barnes, Leonardtown requested G.P.A, also Everitt Joy Hollywood.

Board granted Wm. Hall \$6.00 for one month, and Rodie Barnes \$5.00 for one payment, and Everitt Joy \$6.00 month.

Mrs Attie Wood requested Board to give her money to purchase garden seed.

W. H. Mattingly and Douglas Russell requested Board to try to get Leonard Spalding (removed from work on State Roads, due to deafness) reinstated.

Clerk directed to write Mr. Webb to attend Board meeting Apr. 12.

Mrs. Garland Clark requested Board to improve the south end of the Road from NO 5 State Road towards Cardinal Gibbons Institute.

Mr. S. Sprigg Reeves, requested Board to execute a quit claim deed, for any right or title of said Board of County Commissioners, in or to an old roadway, which runs through the lot which he has purchased from the heirs of the late Geo. R. Garner, at Chaptico, Md, known as the old store lot. Said old roadway run ning past the dwelling house belonging to Mrs . Scheckells, Mr# Van Ward, and Mr. Thomas, and said conveyance referring only to the title to said roadway, so far as same crosses the property belonging to Mr. Reeves.

The Board agreed to do this provided an outlet be provided Mr. Van Ward's lot by putting # in necessary culvert and gravel to give him access to State Road leading from Chaptico to Maddox.
