Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Janie Lawrence, Callaway, Henrietta Chesley, St. Inigoes, applied for G.P.A Mrs Meredith of Welfare Board requested G.P.A. for Janie Gladden, Drayden. Board rejected all three cases.

Mr. Baldwin, Architect again interviewed Board and presented plans of a modern jail and jailors residence. Mr. Baldwin offered his services to the Board, not only as an Architect, but to assist in obtaining Federal Funds for this construction, arranging for bids, and other details incident to this project. Board decided that it was not prepared to take any definite action at this time.

Mr. Tippet requested Board for action on the proposed road from the Three Notch Road to Chesepeake Bay (Near St. James Church). Board requested Mr. Webb for a report on this road.

At this meeting the following resolutions were adopted:  
Authorizing the State Roads Commission to charge the cost of the Mechanicsville- Chaptico Road, a W.P.A. Project in the amount of \$1625.00 to the St. Mary's County Maintenance Fund.

Authorizing the State Roads Commission to charge the approximate overdraft of \$3000.00 to the St. Mary's County Maintenance Fund.

Authorizing the State Roads Commission to reduce the ordinary maintenance work in St. Mary's Co. to approximately \$2500.00 per month for the remainder of the fiscal year.
