Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Mrs. Edmunds heading a delegation from the 7th Dist, requested Board to take over as a County Road, section of road from White Neck State Road to Bloomfield a distance of 1 mile. Board agreed to accept Right of Way Deed for same and recommend same to S. R. C. for maintenance.

Mr C. W. Strickland, heading a delegation from 8th Dist, petitioned the Board to Build as a State Road or improved road, section of road from California to Patuxent Beach and Upper Town Point. (Held for consideration

Mr. Philip H. Dorsey, requested Board to Take over as a County Road, the Queen Tree Road in 6th. Dist. Mr. Webb requested to report on same.

Mr Alton Jump, of E. E. Woolen Co. C.P.A. submitted a bid of \$200. for the Audit of the Books of the Co. Comm. Office. Board accepted the Bid.

Jos Bennett, Hermanville, Pat Dorsey Mechanicsville, Mrs. Wilson Wood, Morganza, applied for G. P. A. Board granted Pat Dorsey, \$8.00 per mo.

Miss Dent of School Board interviewed Board of Co. Comm. in reference to an appropriation for additional room at Margaret Brent H. S. The Board consented to Miss Dent preparing application for this project under W.P.A, and report back to the Co. Comm. as to the cost and other details of this project. Board made not definite committment in the matter.

Miss Dent futher indicated her desire for a New Consolidated School at Mechanicsville and Leonardtown.

Mr. R. H. Pembroke, Chairman Welfare Board and Mrs. P. J. Bean, laid before the Board of CO. Comm, the Budgett for 1938-1939. This Budgett embraced a total expenditure of \$76,335.31. The major increase in this over the preceeding year is reflected in the O.A. Pensions, an additional cost to the County of \$1,741.29 over last year. ###

Clerk directed to write Mr. Joe Chaney , of S.R.C. requesting that Leonard Spalding be reinstated as a laborer on road work.

Clerk directed to write Mr. Stewart Burch, Oakley, that the Canoe Neck Road would be staked out by Mr. Webb by May 28th, and that the final survey would be as staked out by Mr Webb. Mr Burch asked to advise the Board if the road as laid out by Mr meets with his approval. if not no futher effort would be made to build the road.
