Miss Dent requested Board to approve an application to The Federal Government for P.W.A. Funds for Addition Margaret Brent School. Baord authorized Clerk to prepare and sign necessary applications.

Roland Duke and others of Fire Department, requested Board to make an additional appropriation \$300. for the Fire Department, due to the Department having purchased a New Fire Truck, especially designed for rural work, thereby contracting a very heavy obligation . Board unanimously voted to contribute \$300.00 from the Dog Fund.

Walter Baitzell, Avenue, requested Board to pay the St. Mary's Hospital \$42.00 for hospitalization of his son, and Dr. Welch \$75.00 for operation. Board agreed to pay Hospital bill at rate charged for County Patients, but refused to pay Doctor Welch's bill for operation.

With referencex to selling of dog licenses, the commissioners agreed that each Commissioner would appoint a Special Officer for each of his three ~~Districts~~ Districts, to canvass and sell dog licenses, the fee to be 25 cts for each license sold including kennell licenses. Aug.15 was set as the time all dog owners must purchase license, a penantlyt to be imposed after that time.

Special Officer.

Each ~~Special Officer~~ to be entitled to a fee of 25 cts. for licenses purchased from Treasurer's Office by a dog owner, provided the appointee actually called upon the said owner, and provided such license was purchased from the Treasurers Office, subsequent to the time of the appointment of the Special Officer.

Clerk authorized to negotiate a loan of \$9,000.00 from either of ^{the} local Banks, to be ^{repaid} ~~matured~~ of a ~~###~~ ^{period} of 10 years, said funds to be used to match Federal Funds, ~~for~~ the addition to Margaret Brent School.
