

Board met Aug 9 1938

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Mr. C.P. Speith, requested Board to provide him an outlet to the Compton State Road, and Mr. Wm. P. Wise was authorized by Board to look into the matter to see what could be done.

Boar agreed to accept Right of Way Deed for section of Road from Cross Head towards Great Mills, 3/4 mile in length, and instructed Clerk to recommend same to S.R.C. ##### for maintenance when deed is filed.

Mrs Beatrice Millison Brodsky, daughter of Mrs Chas Millison, advised the Board Mrs Chas Millison and Brothe r, Simon Sacks, were no longer able to maintain John Sacks at Springfield State Hospital. Mrs Millison however agrees to pay \$29.00 per year towards his ##### maintenance at Springfield.

Mr. Bernard McKay heading a delegation from 2nd District rewusted Board to take over as a County Road the .7 mile of road leading into McKay's Beach. Mr. Webb requested to make a report on this road.

Mr. Chas Meyers and Mrs R.H. Sears, requested Board to improve the road from Compton State Road to R.H. Sears' property.

Mr. Chas. S Grayson heading a delegation from 1st. District, requested Board to improve the road from # 5 to Villa.

Board requested Mr. Webb to attend the Aug 23 meeting of Board to discuss these two requests.

Board accepted Right of Way Deed from 3 Notch Road towards Chesapeake Bay and recommended same to S.R.C. for maintenance. (Tippett Road)
Board agreed to accept Right of Way Deed for section of Road in 1st Dist. known as Long Neck Road.

Clerk directed to write Mr. Webb recommending the improvement of the Hollywod - St. Johns Road as far as Hickory Hill.

Clerk directed to write Mr. Webb to improve the Road from # 5 to St. Jerome's Creek, a distance of 1 mile. Work to be done in 1939.

Board selected Mr. Stephen M. Jones and Mr Jos F Crew, as new members of Welfare Board to fill vacancies caused by expiration of terms of office of Mr. R. H. Pembroke, and Mr. Elmer Jarboe.

Walter Biscoe, Ridge, Md requested aid from the Board, he having had his house damaged by lightning to the extent of \$50.00. Rejected.

Philip Brown, Morganza requested G.P.A. Board granted \$3.00 for one payment only.

Mr. Johnson McFetridge, requested Board to refund to him taxex and other costs, for property sold by the County in 1928. Mr. McFetridge purchasaded the property, and has paid taxes on same for 16 years, however same property was assessed to Capt. Thos. 9th District. Matter held over.
