

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Father McKenna requested road to Villa be improved, and Mr Kennedy Heard requested the Hayden Bridge Road be repaired.

Mr. Jno. H.T Briscoe & Mr. Hedges, presented a Petition requesting the Board to take into the County Road System, the road from end of #### present County Road, at Barn on Briscoe farm, through the farms of Jno. H. T. Briscoe to the farm of Murray & Freeman, 6th Dist. Complaints were made as to the condition of culverts on the Compton - Bayside Road.

Mr. Webb was requested to attend the Board meeting Oct 25, in reference to the Villa Road, was requested to make a report on the Briscoe road, requested to repair the Hayden Bridge Road, and repair the culverts on the Compton- Bayside road.

Mr. C. P. Speith applied for G.P.A. Not granted.

Mr. Plummer Evans, Great Mills, requested additional allowance from G.P.A Funds. Board allowed increase of \$2.00 per. month. (Letter to J.A.Cecil) Board allowed Jno. H. Welch, Budds Creek, Md. \$6.00 per month G.P.A.

Board accepted Right of Way Deed from Mrs. Stewart H. Edmonds et al for section of road from State Road near Milestown to tenant house on farm of Mrs Edmonds, and recommended same to the State Roads Commission for maintenance. 7th Dist.

Mrs. Jennie R. Millison signed an agreement to pay the Co. Commissioners \$62.50 per year towards the maintenance of Jno. Sacks at Springfield State Hospital. Said agreement to be effective from July 1st. 1938 and to terminate upon the discharge of Jno Sacks from Springfield.Hospital.

Board authorized the sum of \$613.89 for the maintenance of indigent patients at Rosewood State Training School be charged to the 1938 Surplus Account, this item not being included in the 1938 Levy.
