Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

There was general discussion of the question of roads to be recommended to the State Roads Commission for improvement during present year. The Board decided that it did not have sufficient information at hand, in regard to projects authorized but not completed, to adopt a program and instructed the clerk to write Mr Wm. A. Codd, Chief Auditor, State Roads Commission and ask him to break down the item "Balance unpaid on authorized obligations \$45,663.12", in such a manner as to enable them to decide just which authorized projects remained to be finished. The Board also instructed the clerk to write Mr. Elmer R. Jarboe, member of the State Roads Commission, requesting his aid in getting this matter straight, and also in formulating a road construction program.

On the recommendation of Dr. F. F. Greenwell the Board committed Willie Wood to the Alms House. Dr. Greenwell informed the Board that Wood was too old to look after himself, and there was no one else to look after him.

The Board adopted the following resolution: and instructed the Clerk to provide a copy for Senator [unclear] and request him to bring it to the attention of the General Assembly.

The County Commissioners of St. Mary's County wish to call to the attention of the General Assembly the problem that confronts the children ~~xxxxxxx~~ attending schools in St. Mary's County. Approximately one half of the children of school age attend non-state aided schools. These schools are faced with the possibility of closing unless some provision for transportation is made. The problem is urgent and until a more equitable way is found we favor the passage of a local measure to enable us to grant immediate relief, and if the local bill now pending in the Senate is passed we will act favorable upon it.

The Board adjourned until next meeting.
