Board met. Present J. Claude Johnson, President

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

There was general discussion of roads.

Mr. Geo L Bollman, Piney Point Shores, appeared before the Board in reference to deeds and right of way for road to Piney Point Shores. The board agreed to accept deeds for this road, and make it a part of the County road system.

Mr. Jeff Clark, et al, asked the Board to widen and improve the Great Mills-Drayden road, offering the County the necessary gravel for this work free. Mr Webb agreed to do the necessary work on the worst places.

T. C. Carpenter, et al, asked the improvement of the Gardiners Mill- Bethel Church road.

Dr. F. F. Greenwell, asked for the improvement of the Mackintosh road.

Mr. Jno. M. Wible requested that a report be asked from Mr. Webb on the cost of repairing the Vista road. 6th Dist.

Mr. Norman Yates, asked for improvement of the road running from Leonardtown- Cpmpton State Road to Compton Heard farm.

Mr. J. Frank Combs requested that a report be gotten from Mr. Webb on the cost of resurfacing 1.5 miles of the Horse Head- Great Mills road, on the Horse Head end of the road.

The Clerk was instructed to refer all the above roads and the Compton Bayside road to Mr K. O. Webb, State Roads Commission, for a report on the advisability and probable cost of improving these roads.

On the recommendation of Mr. J. Claude Johnson the Board agreed to build a bridge, to cost about \$250.00, on the road running to Mr. Foley Mattingly's, near Helen.

The completion of the Chaptico- Mechanicsville road, having been authorized, by the old Board of Commissioners, as a W. P. A. project, no further action was taken on this road.

The Clerk was instructed to write the State Roads Commission approving the Widening of Madison St. Leonardtown, as a part of # 5 State Road. Also to request them to build about 1.25 miles of State Road, starting from the # 5 State Road at Morganza and running towards Oraville. And about one mile of State Road starting from the Three Notch Road at Oraville and running towards Trent Hall, to connect with and complete the present Trent Hall road.

The Board agreed to accept deeds and right of way for the Leonard Alvey road and make it a part of the County Road System.

Mr. Geo. Quirk, et al, appeared before the Board and requested that the Public Landing at Millstone be not sold by the County. The Board agreed that they would not sell this Landing. They further asked that the Board build a public wharf at Millstone. Board took this matter under advisement and agreed to meet a Committee at Millstone on Sunday Feb. 19th, at 2 P. M. for the purpose of inspecting this project.

The Board refused to accept, as a part of the County Road system, the road running from the Three Notch road below Hermanville to a Development on Cheasepeake Bay, petitioned for by Ray H. Couleman, et al.

The Board agreed to refurnish the Judges room, in the Court House, and ordered a new desk, book-case, three chairs and floor covering, to cost a total of \$202.10, less 2%

The Board agreed to sell to Jos. M. Mattingly the John Holly property, 1st District, for all taxes and costs due County.

Miss Lettie Marshal Dent explained to the Board the delay in starting the addition to Margaret Brent High School.

The Clerk was instructed to write Mrs. Charlotte Fowler and Jos. B. Drury former Treasurers of the County, in regard to the restoration of funds waived by them in the Treasurers accounts in the First National Bank of St. Mary's in 1933. Said funds having since been turned back to the County Commissioners, but restored by the Bank to each of the former Treasurers.
