Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Dr. Metcalf, Mechanicsville requested the Board to intercede with the W.P.A. with a view to having his son Francis O.H. Metcalf reinstated as Librarian. The Board agreed to do this and instructed the Clerk to write the Director of W.P. for this District.

Mr. Elmer Norris, Bruce Quade, Jno. D. Young and Fenney Bailey requested the Board to accept right of way to, and make it a part of the County road system, road running from Palmer's Store to Waterloo, about .75 miles 7th Dist. Mr. Webb asked to report on advisability of accepting road.

The Board agreed to accept deeds to right of way, and make them a part of the County road system of the Camp Dinges road about .9 mile, 7th Dist. Cost of repairs to this road not to exceed \$150.00. Any help the interested Partys might donate to be used in addition to above amount. ~~Also agreed~~ ~~xxxxxxx~~ And the Kingston Creek road about .9 mile, 8th Dist.

Mr. Williamson P. Smith, Scotland, requested that the road to St. Michael's Manor be made a part of the County road system. no action taken

Board authorized the surface treatment of about 1.5 miles of the Great Mills-Horsehead road, on the Horsehead end, to cost about \$1062.00, and the construction of a bridge over Chancelor's run on this road, cost about \$250.00

Clerk instructed to write the State Roads Commission, and ask them to construct, as a State Roads project, a Bridge over the Indian Bridge run and about 150 ft. of approaches on each end of Bridge, on the Indian Bridge road. 8th Dist., and to write Mr K.O. Webb asking him to repair about 900 ft. running from the present improved section to Mr. W.V. James farm in the 5th Dist, of the Budds Creek- Gardiners Mill road. To cost about \$170.00.

Board authorized Mr. Roger Richardson to lay the floor covering in the Judge's room in the Court House, work to be done this week.

Board refunded \$10.50, 1937 taxes paid in error by W.H. Mattingly, Abell, Md.

Mr. G. E. Thomas, St. Georges Island, Md. appeared before the Board in the interest of his sister, now a patient in the Sheppard-Pratt hospital. He stated that this hospital did not want to keep his sister (Miss Bessie Thomas), any longer and asked the Board to commit her to Spring Grove State Hospital. Mr. Thomas agreed to reimburse the County for all maintenance cost. The Board agreed to do this when Mr Thomas had obtained two Doctors certificates, and when Spring Grove would receive her.

Board authorized Mr. Harding Brown, Park Hall, to allow Rosie Hawkins food to the extent of \$2.50 a week for 4 weeks, GPA., and granted Ella Reeder, Leonardtown, \$8.00 for one month; and agreed to continue Jno. Alvey, Mechanicsville, on payroll @ \$15.00 per Month until he is old enough for O.A.L. and authorized J.A. Cecil, Great Mills to increase the allowance for food to Plummer Evans to \$9.00 per month. The applications of Mrs Mary Downes, Avenue, Md., and Willie Nash, Leonardtown, Md. for GPA. taken under advisement.

Clerk was instructed to write Raley & Hooper, Ridgem, Md. to discontinue the allowance to Henry Trossback, as he is now working on W.P.A.

The Board accepted the offer of Mr. Alton S. Jump, to audit the books of this office for \$200.00. The work to be done after the close of the present fiscal year. *Board signed deed to property formerly owned by County at tax sale to Frederick & Violet M Saunders*
