Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Miss Lettie M. Dent, Superintendent of Public Schools, appeared before the Board in regard to the repairing of the Leonardtown Public School building;

Miss Dent inquired ~~XXXXXX~~ if it would be agreeable to this Board to have only temporary repairs made to this building, and after deducting the cost of these repairs from \$2000.00 place the remainder of this fund in a special building fund with a view to eventually building a new school in Leonardtown. The Board decided that it would adhere to its original decision to provide a sum not in excess of \$2000.00 for the repair and improvement of this building.

Justice of Peace Allan H. Sydnor presented a petition signed by prominent Taxpayers of the 7th Dist., requesting the Board to increase the salary of Mr. Sydnor to \$100.00 per year, in view of the fact that he has a large amount of work to do in his Dist. No action taken.

The Board instructed the Clerk to order the necessary equipment to enable the Inspector of weights and measures to proceed with his work.

Dr. F. A. Camalier, representing the "Lions Club" urged the Board to provide for a laboratory at St. Mary's Hospital. Dr. Camalier stated that the Hospital would supply room for the laboratory and that he thought that sufficient equipment could be purchased for \$400.00, and that the probable cost of maintenance per year would be \$75.00 for materials and \$900. per year for a Nurse qualified as a Technician and that the Hospital would bear one Half of the Nurse's salary, making the net cost of maintenance to the County about \$525.00 per year. No action taken.

The Board committed Regis Guy to Spring Grove State Hospital, as of July, 15, 1940.

The Board instructed the Clerk to ascertain from St. Mary's Hospital just what rule was applied in determining when a charity Patient was to be a direct County charge when such a case was covered by the State appropriation for charity Patients.

The Board executed a deed to T. L. Combs for the Bogden lot (tax sale prop) 2nd Dist.

Kennie Heard and Rex Wills requested the Board to accept into the County road system, for maintenance, road running from Mr Lester Mattingly's place on the St. John's Church road to Mr Heard's place about 1.25 miles. #rd Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Heard.

B. L. Jackson, Roger Elliott, B. L. Jackson Jr., H. E. Jones, J. M. Henderson and U. W. Smith requested the Board To accept into the County road system and build the road from the end of the present Clarks Mill County road to Cuckhold Creek. about 1 mile. 6th Dist. It was stated that Mr. Roger Elliott would donate the gravel for building this road. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr U. W. SMith.

Mr. John W. Hurry requested aid for Jack Young. Mr Hurry was advised that the Welfare board had allowed Young \$8.00 per month GPA. The Board agreed to provide the Welfare Board with \$2.50 extra each month to enable them to grant James Purcell \$5.00 per month Gpa until he is able to get O. AR. The Board granted the Welfare Board 1.50 for WM. Farrell and 1.50 for Joseph Goldsborough, as temporary GPA.

Peter Biscoe asked aid for Susie Long. He was referred to the Welfare Board.
