Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Mr. Hiram Millison applied for permission To construct a slip for his boat near the County wharf at Millstone Public Landing. The Clerk was instructed to write Mr. Millison that ~~the~~ Board had no objection to the building of this slip provided it was detached from the wharf and did not interfere with the use of the wharf or the Public Landing.

The Clerk was instructed to write all the St. Mary's County Doctors and ask them to express their views as to the need for, and advisability of the County providing for a Laboratory at St. Mary's Hospital.

Mr. Chas. Mattingly, Sanat-arian, reported a number of Public Toilets to be in an unsanitary condition due to ~~the~~ abuse by the public. Clerk instructed to post notices in the Toilets in the Court House, warning the public against ~~the~~ careless and improper use of them.

The Board agreed to build a bulkhead for the protection of the Approach to the wharf at Millstone Public Landing at a cost of \$225.00.

The Board accepted the Burr Oak, planted in the Court House grounds by Mrs. Mary G. Love, and dedicated to the memory of the late Philip Greenwell Love, Judge of the Orphans Court.

Mr. D?G? Stevens reported that the bridge near Trailors Store on the road from above Stre to Hermanville, to be in a dangerous condition. Mr. Thompson asked to investigate and make the needed repairs.

Capt. McLean requested a Culvert at his Entrance, 8th Dist. Mr Thompson asked to see what can be done.

The Board granted Mrs Mabel A. Talbott, a Veterans widow, Temporary GPA Of \$5.00 to enable her to get to Washington To try to find employment.
