Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Robt Ennis, Atty, presented to the Board a copy of an amended bill filed in the Circuit Court to have the tax sale of Viola Jenkins property, 3rd Dist. set aside.

The Following resolution was unambiguously adopted:

Resolved that the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County will enter into a written ~~agreement~~ contract with the Director and one or more responsible Citizens of St. Mary's County for the transportation to and from school of all children of school age attending schools not receiving State Aid, namely: Holy Angels School, Avenue, Md.; Immaculate Conception School, Mechanicsville, Md.; St. Michael's School, Ridge, Md.; St. Peter Claver School, Ridge, Md.; Little Flower School, Great Mills, Md.; St. Johns School, Hollywood, Md.; Our Lady's School, ~~Beauvois~~ Md.; St. Joseph's School, Morganza, Md and Sacred Heart School, Bushwood Md. Provided that before entering into such contract the parties to the contract shall enter into bond for such amount as is approved by the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County for the faithful performance of the duties reposed in them.

Mr. Vivian Norris, Combs Abell, Sterling Tennyson, and Brennan Norris appeared before the Board and requested that the road running from the Great Mills-Horsehead road to Mr. Brennan Norris' place be improved, about .7 mile, 8th Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Brennan Norris.

Mr. Bevans Morris and Mr. Tompkins Abell complained that the part of the Jutland road, 1st Dist. which had been thrown up, but not finished, needed something done about drainage, as the water was backing up and the road would soon be impassable. Mr. Thompson asked to look into the matter and to contact Mr. Tompkins Abell.

The Clerk was instructed to recommend to the State Roads Commission, for acceptance into the County road system, for maintenance, the road from near the Colored High School on the 3 Notch road to Piney Hill, about .75 mile, 8th Dist.
